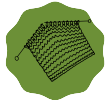


Aiguilles circulaires n°5.5
câble de 40 ou 60 cm



Fil à tricoter suggéré: Fil à Tricoter Alpaga
Soie Aran – Ferme Récréative Caza et
Alpagas
Quantité: 1 écheveau 150 mètres 50 gr

Détails



Échantillon 10 cm = 15-16 mailles



Taille 20 x 60 cm



Abbréviations

m. end.: maille endroit
m. env.: maille envers

Instructions



Cast on 96 stitches loosely.
Join in the round, being careful not to twist your stitches.
Ensure all stitches are facing inward.



Round 1: Purl.
Round 2: Knit.
Round 3: Purl.
Round 4: K3, p3 repeat from * to end of round.
Rounds 5 to 7: Repeat Round 4.
Round 8: P3, k3 repeat from * to end of round.
Rounds 9 to 11: Repeat Round 8.
Repeat Rounds 4 to 11 a total of 5 times.
Round 52: Purl all stitches.
Round 53: Knit.
Round 54: Purl all stitches.



Bind off loosely.
Weave in ends.



Notes: To make the cowl longer, repeat Rounds 4 to 11 until the desired length is reached.
